

Vet 2 Vet Service Dogs Potential Paperwork Needed

After submitting a Service Dog Application, each veteran will be interviewed by phone or in person by one of our team members and at that point we will discuss the need for specific documentation. Examples of *possible* documents required are listed below.

- 1. <u>DD-214</u> (4 copies)
- 2. <u>Letter of Support</u> from a friend or family member that states their support of the veteran in their commitment to our program.
- 3. <u>Letter of Recommendation</u> from a licensed mental health provider stating that the veteran has a diagnosis that will benefit from the commitment to a service dog.
- 4. <u>Biography</u> This should be a heartfelt explanation of the veterans time and service and what led them to this point in needing a service dog.
- 5. 3 references
 - a. 2 professional
 - b. 1 personal
